

## **Fredrik Zetterquist**

Mr. Zetterquist has an MSc in Land Administration from The Royal Institute of Technology, Stockholm in 1991. After his study he worked as a lecturer for four years and was then employed by Swedesurvey, the overseas agency of Lantmäteriet (the Swedish mapping, cadastral and land registration authority), responsible for the establishment of a Land Management Department at a state University in Russia. After his return to Sweden in 1996, and until 2008, he worked as adviser and project manager in numerous long-term land administration and capacity development projects throughout the world, with emphasis on the land reforms in the former Soviet Union republics. Between 1996 and 1998, he did part-time PhD studies in 3D city modelling. Mr. Zetterquist also founded a company to conduct due diligence for larger companies on land-related matters. Between 2008 and 2011, as the Deputy Director he was instrumental in bringing up a large-scale farm enterprise in Russia (65,000 ha, 250 employees), in compliance with global social, ethical, environmental and legal performance indicators. In 2012, Mr. Zetterquist was appointed Managing Director for Swedesurvey. In 2018, he was recruited by Ordnance Survey (UK) as Head of Land Administration, to lead the development and management of an innovative and scalable driven portfolio of global consulting and managed services in land administration. From August 2019, Mr. Zetterquist is University Lecturer in Land Administration at the University of Gävle (Sweden), including development of an MSc program in land administration. Mr. Zetterquist was elected Chair of the UNECE Working Party on Land Administration in March 2017.
