First Nation Reserve lands under a Land Code (presented by Andrew Beynon)

- This presentation will discuss the management of First Nations lands and resources by the First Nations themselves
- Portions of the Indian Act still apply to all other aspects (i.e. education, health care, etc.) but the lands and resource management is with the First Nation
- The First Nations create a Land Code which replaces the 44 sections of the Indian Act that no longer apply
- First Nations are responsible for environmental management and enforcement as well
- The Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management is the Government to Government agreement that applies to the lands and resource management
