

Council Report – May 17 to June 7, 2021

The Association of Canada Lands Surveyors Council met on May 17 and June 7, 2021. Amongst the items discussed, were the following:

- Awarding of a CLS Commission to Michael Haines
- Review of financial reports up to end of March 2021
- Decision to ask the Indigenous Relations Coordinating Committee to review the Best Practices Pages on First Nation Consultation and Approvals and Title Searching
- Decision to ask the CPD Committee to consider the idea of mandatory CPD for all Regular members and come back to Council with its recommendation
- A task force will work on building a Governance Learning Centre for use by Council.
- Approved the National Conference Committee recommendation to hold the 2022 National Conference in May in the Brookstreet Hotel and Conference Center
- Approved the National Conference Committee recommendation to sign the Rod Brudenell Resort contract for NSC 2024
- Approval of the new Discipline Committee Terms of Reference
- Council welcomed its new NRCan Minister appointed Council member, Gordon MacInnis from Prince Edward Island
- Appointment of Gordon MacInnis to the Discipline Committee
- In response to the business meeting motion to consider changes to the by-law section on the monument fee, decision to set up a working group to look into this and report back to Council
- A Council Learning Centre is now available. We will continue to populate it.
- Approval of changes to Governance Policy number 2.8 on Compensation and Benefits and 1.9 on Committee Structure
- Decision to hold its fall face-to-face meeting at the Brookstreet Hotel and Conference Center on November 25 and 26, 2021
- Adjustments were made to the salaries of three ACLS administrative staff members
