		 The increase nationally in infrastructure projects and a backlog in residential will drive the demand for surveyors over the next two years, with a peak in demand in 2023/24 requiring 20,200 professionals. In the same year, the capability gap will reach 1,500 professions as new supply from graduates falls short of the increased demand. This presentation will identify the focus areas for the profession in the coming few years to ensure a sustainable and increased output from the workforce is achieved.
